

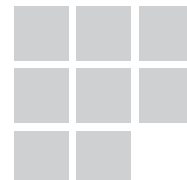

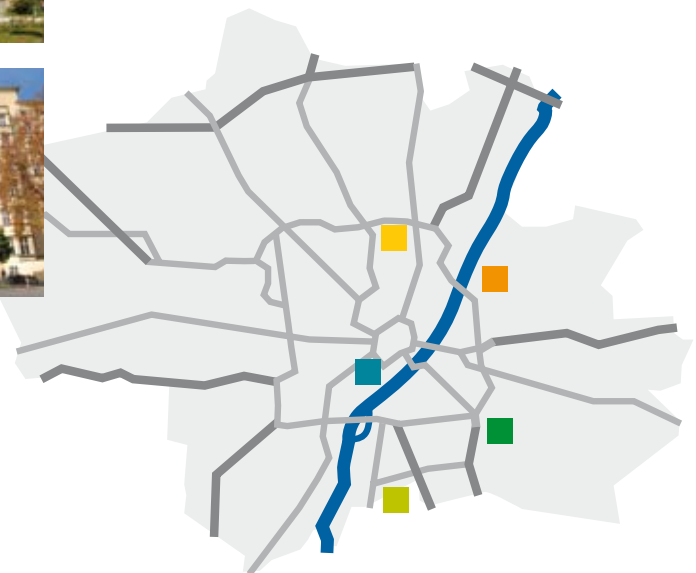

Main Focus: Interdisciplinary emergency medicine, short-track intensive medicine

Main Focus: Minimal-invasive reconstruction of mitral- and aortic valve, complete myocardial revascularisation with double mammary surgery, valvular surgery (aortal, mitral, tricuspidal replacement, mitral valve reconstruction), aortal surgery including supra-aortal branches, cardiac tumour, rhythm surgery

Main Focus: Cardiac catheter laboratory with 24-hour on-call service for the invasive emergency treatment of patients with acute coronary syndrome, day clinic with 4 treatment places for out-patient cardiac catheter, cardio version and tilting table examination/investigation of syncope, implantation of all pace-maker systems including cardiac resynchronisation therapy and AICD implantation (automatic implantable cardioverter defibrillator), invasive diagnostics and therapy of coronary and valve patients with restricted kidney function



■ Department of Trauma Surgery, Orthopaedics and Reconstructive Surgery

Main Focus: Bronchoscopy suite offering a 24/7 service. (Flexible and rigid bronchoscopy including endobronchial ultrasound, kryo, laser and argon plasmer beamer techniques). High standard lung function laboratory, including cardiopulmonary exercise testing. Endoscopy unit (high resolution video technique, ERCP, endosonography), and ultrasound unit (contrast medium enhanced investigations, vascular duplex, ultrasound guided puncture techniques)

Main Focus: Central contact point for all emergency cases, 24/7 coverage of emergencies, intensive care unit with emphasis on medical intensive care, special expertise in treating severe sepsis/septic shock.

Main Focus: Anaesthesiologic care of high-risk patients using state of the art methods of general and regional anaesthesia, differential perioperative pain therapy, obstetric pain relief using special methods, intensive therapy of multimorbid and polytraumatised patients, interdisciplinary day clinic for pain diagnostics and therapy



■ **Department of Diagnostic and Interventional Radiology, Neuroradiology and Nuclear Medicine**

Main Focus: Paediatric MRT (magnetic resonance imaging) under narcosis, interventions and angioplasties in all vascular sections including dialysis shunts and chemo-embolization of the liver, multislice-CT with direct link to emergency room, whole spectrum of nuclear medicine including pain therapy and SLN (sentinel lymph node), complete mamma diagnostics within the scope of the Certified Breast Centre, endovascular therapy of acute stroke and of subarachnoid haemorrhage, CT- and ultrasound controlled puncture and drainage

Main Focus: Intensive care medicine including organ replacement technique, 24h-cardiac catheter stand-by, interventional therapy even for complex lesions (e.g. main stem stenosis, rotablation angiography), Life Bridge, intracoronary diagnostics, (IVUS/intravascular ultrasound, pressure wire), valvuloplasty, PFO (patent foramen ovale) and ASD (atrial septal defect) constriction, catheterisation interventions in major arteries (carotis, aorta etc.), pacemaker and defibrillator implantation, resynchronization therapy

Main Focus: Full and partial in-patient acute geriatric treatment of multimodal elderly patients, day clinic with memory clinic for diagnostics and therapy of cognitive deficiencies, standardised interdisciplinary assessment, interdisciplinary therapy team, complex geriatric and preliminary rehabilitation treatment



■ Department of Endocrinology, Diabetology, Angiology and Internal Medicine

Main Focus: Training, diagnostics, therapy of diabetes mellitus, nutritional advice and therapy, diagnostics and therapy of arterial, venous and inflammatory vascular disorders, investigation and therapy of endocrinal dysfunction, central emergency room

Main Focus: Endoscopic therapy of larger polyps and early carcinomas including ESD-technique (endoscopic submucosal dissection), obstructive jaundice (stones, tumours) including laser and PDT (photodynamic therapy), double balloon and capsule enteroscopy, radiofrequency ablation, IBD-patients (inflammatory bowel disease), EUS-driven drainage (endoscopic ultrasound), certified intestine centre, abdominal centre (interdisciplinary)



■ Department of General- and Visceral Surgery, Endocrine Surgery and Coloproctology

Main Focus: Oncological surgery of the entire gastrointestinal tract with focus on colorectal and hepatobiliary-pancreatic surgery (certified Colorectal Cancer Centre). Esophageal and gastric surgery, endocrine surgery, hernia surgery, minimal invasive surgery, interdisciplinary therapy of chronic inflammatory bowel disease, surgical treatment of complex anal fistula and incontinence.

Main Focus: Family oriented obstetrics, breech presentation consultation and vaginal breech presentation delivery, abdominal version, Doppler consultation, cooperation with the Breast Centre South in Harlaching Hospital, primary therapy in mammary carcinoma, gynaecological-oncological radical operations, minimal invasive surgery (TLH/total laparoscopic hysterectomy, LASH/laparoscopic supracervical hysterectomy, LAVH/laparoscopic assisted vaginal hysterectomy, myoma nucleation, cystectomy, adnexectomy), reconstructive pelvic floor surgery (TVT/tension-free vaginal tape, prolift, plastic surgery)

■ **Department of Trauma Surgery and Orthopaedics; Central Emergency Room/Surgery Department**

Main Focus: Trauma centre (STMS Schwabing Trauma Management System), polytrauma treatment, correction of unsatisfactory results following fracture treatment, osteomyelitis and septic medical conditions, hand and foot surgery, endoprosthesis, minimal invasive procedures, kyphoplasty, malpositions, osteoporosis-related pain syndromes of the spine, occupational accidents
